

Main task of phytosanitary inspectors at the state border is:





protection the territory of Ukraine from entry or introduction of regulated pests

Detection of Tuta absoluta Meyr.

2012 – 10 samples

2013 – 4 samples


To prevent from entry *Phthorimaea operculella Zell.* and *Tuta absoluta* into the territory of Ukraine since December 1, 2010 import of potato, tomatoes, eggplants and pepper from the Republic of Turkey was prohibited



On January 24, 2011 due to inspection results of Solanaceous products in Turkey the abovementioned prohibition was removed



Holes more than 3 mm in timbers

- Control surveys of agricultural and forestry lands, places for storage and processing of plants and plant products




